...Even when you don't deserve it.

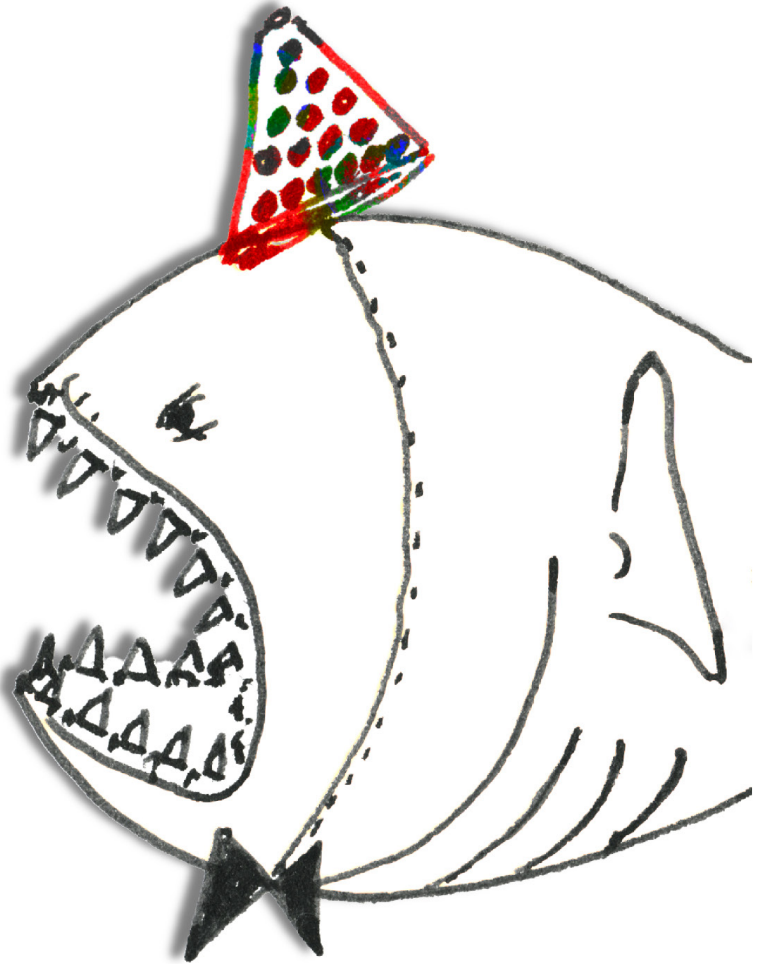
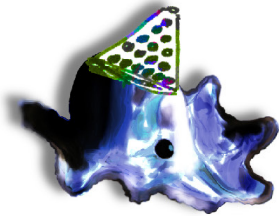

Technically speaking:



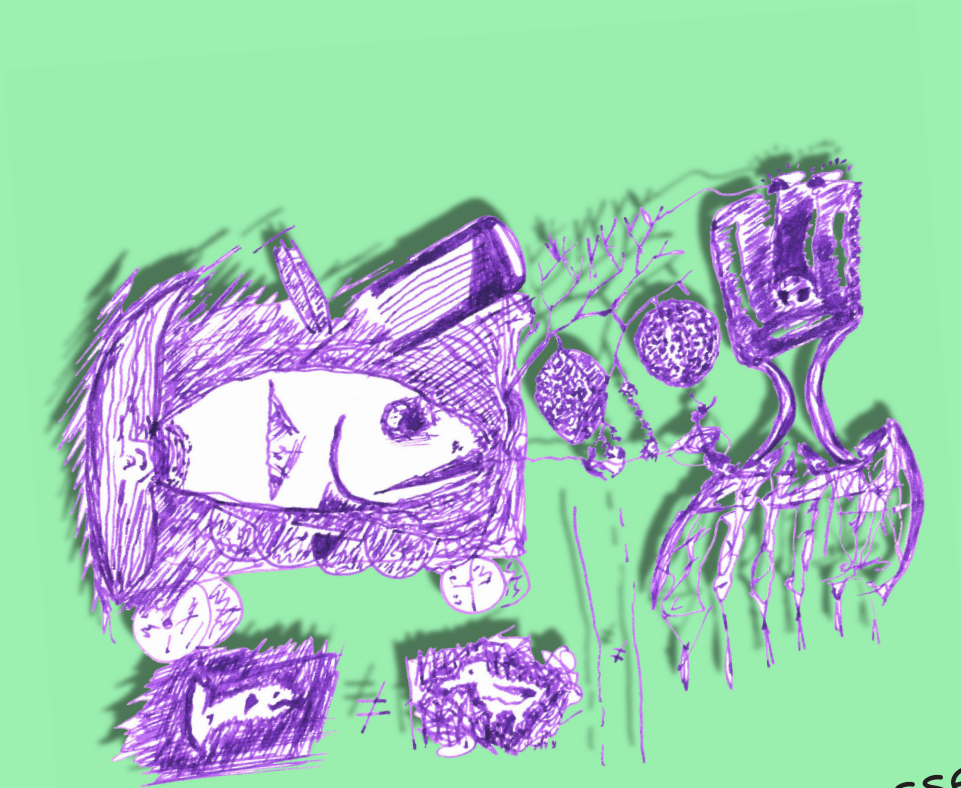

Picture this

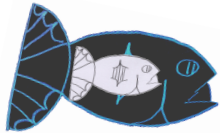

You'll never believe

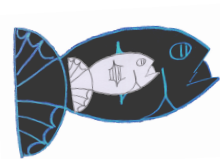
CONCLUDING COMMENTS

Don't risk it; let abstractions guide the way.

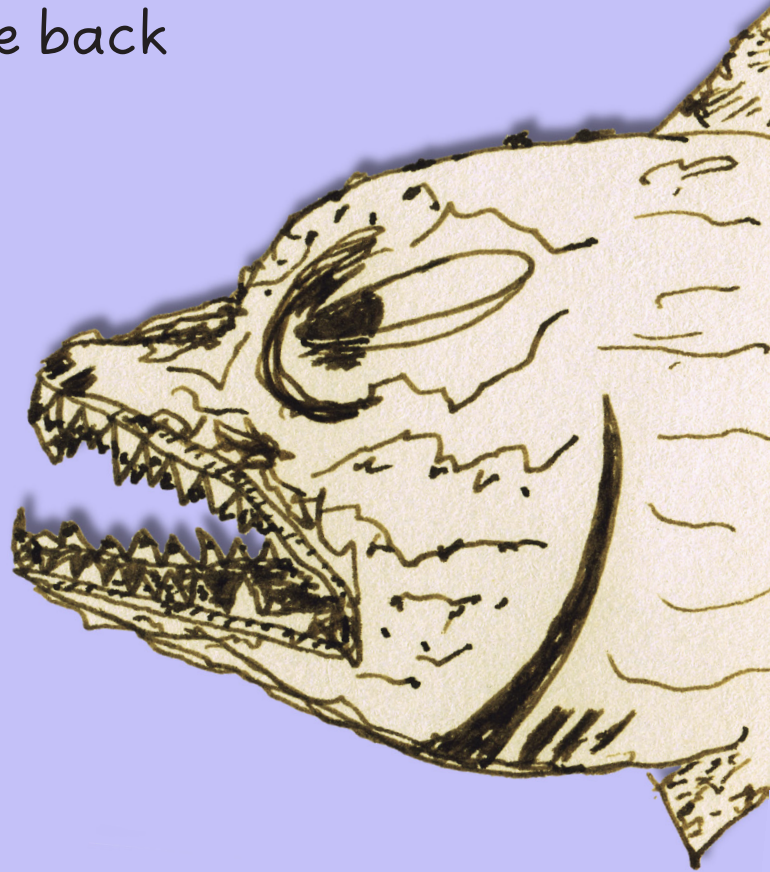
